Oakwood Village East Celebrates Ten Year Anniversary

MADISON, Wisconsin (July 29, 2010) – On Friday, July 30, 2010 Oakwood Village East celebrates ten years of ministry to older adults on Madison's East Side. The anniversary will be marked by a brief outdoor program at 10:30am at Oakwood Village East, 5565 Tancho Drive, followed by a celebratory pig roast from 11:00am – 1:00pm. The University of Wisconsin-Madison Marching Band and T.R. Loon will provide entertainment as a part of the festivities.

The original apartment building on the campus, Pioneer Prairie, was dedicated on July 29, 2000. The first residents began moving into Oakwood Village East on August 1, 2000. Oakwood Village East now offers 206 life lease apartment homes, 60 assisted living accommodations and 42 skilled nursing beds and has grown into one of the few Continuing Care Retirement Communities (offering independent living, assisted living and skilled nursing) in the Madison area. The campus also features a chapel, fitness room, salon, resident business office, craft room, numerous card and game rooms, and a gift shop/grocery store – all connected with indoor walkways.

“Oakwood Lutheran Homes Association, Inc. is extremely proud to celebrate the ten year anniversary of our beautiful Oakwood Village East Campus on Madison's East Side,” shares Joe Xanthopoulos, Oakwood's Chief Operating Officer. “Oakwood Village East offers a full continuum of care with spacious independent living apartment homes, an array of assisted living apartment home options and our highly regarded Health and Rehabilitation Center. Oakwood Village East currently serves 350 residents and employs 204 staff members.
